



IF YOUR GAS METER IS BURIED IN SNOW OR ICE YOU COULD HAVE A PROBLEM

When you shovel the snow off your roof or gravity does the job for you, be sure your meter and/or regulator doesn't get buried in the process. The impact of heavy snow and ice could jar the meter set. If the gas regulator becomes frozen shut, ice may interfere with the supply of gas to your appliances. If your meter is covered with snow right now, play it safe and dig it out.

METER READING & SAFETY REQUIRES CLEAR ACCESS TO METER AT ALL TIMES

Ice & snow may also block the electronic reading of your meter. Our desire is to accurately bill your natural gas usage.

Please keep the area in front of and around your gas meter clear at all times. If you are storing a boat or trailer in front of your meter, try not to completely block the meter off. Do **not** build decks, plant trees or bushes that surround your gas meter.
