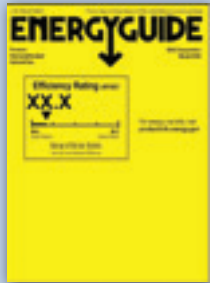

AFUE, UEF, HERS

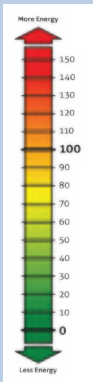
- **How efficient is your furnace?** Check the AFUE or Annual Fuel Utilization Efficiency! The AFUE is listed as a percent of how much fuel your furnace can convert into usable heat. The higher the AFUE percentage, the more efficient the furnace, which means lower heating costs and increased comfort.

PRO TIP: Get a \$350 rebate when you install a 95% AFUE or greater natural gas furnace.



- **What is the UEF of my water heater?** UEF stands for Uniform Energy Factor and measures the efficiency of your water heater. The higher the UEF, the higher the efficiency and the higher your savings! A high efficiency water heater has better insulation, heat traps and more efficient combustion systems and uses about 10% less energy than the standard water heater.

PRO TIP: Install a 0.67 UEF or greater efficiency water heater and earn a \$50 rebate.



- **What is a HERS score?** HERS is a Home Energy Rating System, which measures a home's energy performance. HERS 75 VS. HERS 65? Lower is better! The lower the HERS score, the lower your home energy usage. The HERS score is an easy way to compare homes based on energy performance.
