

GAS METER SURVEY



Intermountain Gas Company personnel will be conducting an atmospheric corrosion survey on gas meters in your area within the next couple of months. Your gas meter may be selected for this survey. This inspection is necessary to comply with federal regulations and requires our employees to physically assess the condition of our meters.

You will be able to recognize Intermountain Gas employees by their personal protective equipment (high visibility vests and clothing) uniforms with the Intermountain Gas logo and they will be driving our company vehicles - though the vehicle may be parked away from their personal location. They also will be carrying handheld tablet computers to complete their work for this survey.

Always allow safe and easy access to your gas meter by keeping the area in front of and around your meter clear at all times. We need at least two feet of clearance to each side of the meter and three feet of clearance in front of the meter to provide visibility and access for routine work and also in case of any emergency.
