What is Energy Assistance or LIHEAP?

The Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program is a federally funded program for qualified households that provides a one-time benefit (per program year) to assist with heating costs.

Essential Energy Assistance Facts

1. Applications may only be submitted to Community Action Agencies and are accepted from Nov. 1 through Jan. 31.
2. The financial eligibility requirement is at or below 60 percent of the state median income (see chart below).
3. Both homeowner and renter households are eligible.
4. There is a one-time benefit per year.
5. Participants must re-apply each year.

IMPORTANT

You must contact your local Community Action Agency to apply for energy assistance. See the list of agencies on the back cover.
