WHAT IS ENERGY ASSISTANCE OR LIHEAP?

Essential Energy Assistance Facts

The Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) is a federally funded program for qualified households that provides a one-time benefit (per program year) to assist with heating costs.

1. Applications may only be submitted to Community Action Agencies and are accepted from October 1st through March 31st.
2. The financial eligibility requirement is at or below 60 percent of state median income. (see chart below).
3. Both homeowner and renter households are eligible.
4. There is a one-time benefit per year.
5. Participants must re-apply each year.
