## What Happens When The Plan Ends?

Since the Winter Payment Plan payments only represent a portion of your actual bill, arrears will accumulate during your participation. Upon completion of the plan, participants are required to contact Intermountain Gas Company to make new payment arrangements which will reduce accumulated arrears.

## Winter Payment Plan



Paying winter heating bills can be a major problem when money is short.

### What Is The Winter Payment Plan?

- The Winter Payment Plan allows qualified customers to pay a portion of their utility bills when they are unable to pay the full amount each month.
- The plan will extend protection from November through March.

#### Who Qualifies?

Any residential customer who declares that he or she is unable to pay in full for utility service and whose household includes children, elderly or infirm persons.

### What Are Participation Requirements?

 Agree to make monthly payments equal to one-half of your Level Pay amount. (monthly average of usage including arrears)

- Required to pay this monthly minimum payment during each of the five winter months of November, December, January, February and March.
- Participants will be disqualified if payments are not made as required.

# What Are The Advantages Of The Winter Payment Plan?

- If you sign up and make your required payments, your service will not be shut off.
- You will be considered to have good credit with the utility and will be better able to set up future payment arrangements.
- If you don't pay anything during the winter, you may be required to pay in full at the conclusion of the winter protection time period.
- No late interest charged as long as you're on the Winter Payment Plan.
